It's the time of year when we start to focus on collecting shoeboxes for Operation Christmas Child. Collection week begins Monday, November 12th so we ask that all completed boxes are delivered to the church by Sunday, November 11th. You can choose to pack a box for either a boy or a girl ages 2-4, 5-9, or 10-14. There is a table of items at the church that you can use or you can choose to fill your own box. It's also best to use a plastic tote the size of a shoebox so that the child can get continue use out from it.

When packing your shoebox there is a list of items that you are asked not to include. They include: soft candy; toothpaste; gum; war related items such as toy guns, knives or military figures; food; chocolate; seeds; fruit rolls or other fruit snacks; drink mixes; liquids or lotions; medications or vitamins; breakable items and aerosol cans.

The church has a detailed list of suggested items as well as instructions on how to pack the box. There are also tags that need to be placed on each box to show the gender and age of the box. You can also visit:
